

## VCKC KAYAKS

All VCKC single kayaks are in the VCKC clubhouse basement storage area. All, except the Inukshuk, are along the west wall (left-hand side after walking through basement door), on the racks in rows 2 and 3. The Inukshuk is on the south side of the stairs that lead to the main floor of the clubhouse (right-hand side when approaching the stairs). The Double is stored outside in bin # 27.

The club kayaks are locked by plastic chains and small combination locks. The kayak locker is on the north-east corner (near the bathroom). Combination numbers are noted in the kayak booking guidelines. Please keep all combinations confidential.

NO.	TYPE	WIDTH	LENGTH	SKEG OR RUDDER
1	Blue <b>Capella</b> – a British style sea kayak that is nice to paddle for the day or overnight. Although a narrow boat (fits small person) it is a stable boat. Does have a tendency to weathercock in moderate wind which may be frustrating for a novice paddler	22”	16’7”	skeg
2	Yellow Current Design <b>Sirocco</b> – a good paddling boat with exceptional manoeuvrability. Has good stability for the novice, but can be edged easily by an experienced paddler. Lots of room for expedition paddling but also makes a great day boat.	23”	16’10”	skeg
3	Yellow Current Design <b>Breeze</b> – With a 25” beam, this is a very stable boat for the beginner. It’s length makes it turn easily with a good sweep stroke. Good day boat for sheltered waters and calm conditions. Will require a little more energy to keep up with the long touring boats.	25”	13’6”	neither
4	Green Current Design <b>Breeze</b> - With a 25” beam, this is a very stable boat for the beginner. It’s length makes it turn easily with a good sweep stroke. Good day boat for sheltered waters and calm conditions. Will require a little more energy to keep up with the long touring boats.	25”	13’6”	rudder
5	Yellow Boreal Design <b>Inukshuk</b> – a comfortable boat to paddle with lots of room for gear. Has good initial stability for the novice paddler but may feel a little tippy if edged by an inexperienced paddle. It’s low rocker tends to make this boat track very well, but makes it a boat that has a larger turning radius.	23 1/2”	17’	rudder
6	Red <b>Necky</b> double : - a nice comfortable and very stable boat for two that is good for day paddling, and short expeditions. Two paddlers can move this boat along at a good speed, despite its weight and width. A good boat for beginners as well as more experienced paddlers who want to share the ride with a friend.	29”	18’	rudder
