# **EXECUTIVE NEWS**

Annual General Meeting, Monthly General Meeting, Storage Renewal and Executive Activity

#### 2015 Annual General Meeting

Mark your calendar: the Annual General Meeting is later for 2015 - January 13<sup>th</sup>. The extra time will allow the treasurer to complete the year end financial statements before the meeting.

#### General Meeting

The next general meeting is October 7<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. Entertainment will be "Gulf Islands history and stories" presented by Ken Gibbard. We will wander through the Gulf Islands from Victoria to Nanaimo looking at the history of settlement and development and hear some stories from over the years of Ken's personal experiences there. Many people on the Gulf Island Brigade raved about Ken's stories when they came home and talked about their experiences. This promises to be a spellbinding story hour.

### Storage renewal

In order to make full year storage available to people on the Boat and Locker wait lists, the executive approved a January 1<sup>st</sup> deadline for storage renewal each year.

This means that membership and storage fees must be paid prior to the new year. Our financial records cannot accept these payments until some time in December. Current members paying storage fees will have a reminder notice when the 2015 payments can be processed.

#### 10 Year Plan

The executive completed the section for VCKC's 2015 Objectives at the September meeting. The sections completed to date are: Background, The Ideal Future for VCKC, What Will VCKC Do to Achieve This Ideal Future, VCKC's Values, Communication Plan, and Objectives and Priorities for the Year 2015. Further work to be done to complete the plan includes: People Development Plan, Operating Budget, Estimated Operating Budget Worksheet, Risks and Opportunities, "Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats Analysis", Risk Register, Success Measures, Management Plan, and The Action Plan.

#### Use/Abuse of the VCKC Clubhouse

During the past few months there have been an increasing number of occurrences where the clubhouse has not been left clean, has not been booked according to policy, and has been used for personal (rather than for club) reasons. Please remember to treat it as it is intended: a clubhouse benefit for club activities and guided by club policies. It must be kept clean, locked and utilities (water, electricity and gas) used for club activities. The shower is maintained for hypothermia emergencies: it is not a personal benefit for paddlers wishing to clean up after paddling. With the onset of winter, the heating costs will go up again. Please don't prop the basement door open when the furnace is required.

### BYOG: Buy Your Own Gear

Paddlers are expected to buy their own pfds, paddles, seat cushions and, for the solo and tandem paddling opportunities, their own boats. Club equipment is for instruction and potential new members to try out the sport. We also make equipment available to our associate members.

Almond Haystacks

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

3 cups slivered almonds 1 cup pecan pieces 1/2 cup white sugar 1/2 tsp vanilla

Separate eggs in the morning and cool egg whites in fridge Whisk 2 egg whites with fork or whisk until frothy Add sugar Add vanilla Whisk until well mixed Stir in nuts

Use teaspoon to spoon onto parchment paper as mounds

Bake for 18-20 minutes Open oven door and cool in place for about 5 minutes to set
